LETTER FROM FOUNDATION BOARD CHAIR BRAD FERRER

Georgia State University enjoyed another year of record-breaking results, from graduation rates to funded research to fundraising.

Our sustained fundraising success over the past four years is a point of pride for me as chair of the Foundation Board and as a Georgia State alumnus. The Foundation raised more than \$30 million this year, the fourth year in a row we have exceeded this milestone. Your generosity continues to help Georgia State open the door to exceptional opportunities for thousands of students and professors.

Scholarship funding by the Foundation, which contributed to these improved graduation rates, has grown an average of 21 percent annually from \$2.9 million in 2011 to \$7.6 million in 2016—a record. And faculty and program support grew this year to \$12 million, another record. Beyond these financial successes, this annual report tells the story of what those resources have the power to make possible. A growing community of support—alumni, parents, businesses, foundations and friends of the university—has witnessed this success and is investing for an even brighter future.

And perhaps the most consequential action your Foundation took this year was to establish a vision for our Foundation as grand as the university we support. Our goal: by 2040, we intend to build an endowment balance in the top 50 among all research and doctoral public universities in the United States. There are 180 similar institutions in the United States today, and our endowment ranks 120th. A top 50 ranking is difficult to imagine today, but when we consider our professors' critical research, or our students' exceptional academic progress, we know this goal is the right one. With your help, we will get there.



The first in his family to attend college,
Dyer earned a B.B.A. in accounting from
the State University of West Georgia,
as well as an executive MBA from Georgia
State University's J. Mack Robinson
College of Business. And, sure enough,
he went on to secure that "better life"
his parents advocated. Starting at Cox
Enterprises in 1977 as an internal auditor,
Dyer has held a number of financial and
operational positions over the years. He
currently serves as president and chief
executive officer of the now \$18 billion
communications, media and automotive
services company.

Dyer attributes much of his success to his time in the Executive MBA program, where he says he developed invaluable time management skills and learned from the program's top-notch professors that "it's not about having the right answer, but having the right question."

Wanting other students to enjoy similar success, Dyer set up the John M. Dyer First-Generation Finance Scholarship in 2013. The fund provides critical scholarship support for undergraduate students in the Robinson College's Department of Finance.

"The business lessons, the academic lessons, and the life lessons I got from that program still help me out today," Dyer says. "And I love it when people who are first-generation have the opportunity to go to school. One of the greatest gifts you can give is to enable people to have the opportunities I've had."

One first-generation student who has benefited from the scholarship is Azhia Brown. She received the Dyer Scholarship and, as a result, was able to stay in school and graduate this past spring with a B.S. in finance. Today she works as a financial analyst at Turner Broadcasting, where she helps manage and allocate the operating budget for CNN News.

Like Dyer, Brown attributes much of her success to Georgia State. "Georgia State's business school is a great school where the professors build you up and you make valuable connections," she says. "The school prepared me to excel in the business world."

As for Dyer, Brown is not only grateful to him, but inspired by him as well. "Mr. Dyer was a first-generation student, and look at what he's done today. If he can do it, I can do it too."

Alumna Kay Craigie Helps Create The Next Generation Of Counterterrorism Experts For A Safer World



Helping college students achieve their educational aspirations and creating a safer world for children may seem like unrelated goals to some, but not to Kay Craigie. She is accomplishing both through her generous support of Georgia State University.

Craigie earned a B.A. in philosophy from Georgia State in 1968. Following graduation, she earned her master's and doctorate degrees from the University of Pennsylvania and went on to teach at the University of Maryland, College Park and Cabrini College. Her volunteer career included work with the American Radio Relay League for 29 years, most recently as president.

As a professional and a volunteer, Craigie says the critical thinking skills she developed at Georgia State have been invaluable. Today she is committed to helping other Georgia State students develop these critical thinking skills as well—especially Ph.D. students in Georgia State's Global Policies Institute, an interdisciplinary effort that examines the causes and consequences of violent extremism.

Toward that end, Craigie established the Craigie International Security Scholars Fund in 2016. The fund provides scholarship support to students whose research closely aligns with that of the institute's faculty.

In creating the fund, Craigie hopes to help the institute foster the next generation of counterterrorism specialists whose work Craigie believes will create a safer world not only for current generations, but for future ones as well.



"I was fortunate to have received a fellowship for graduate studies, and I want to be able to give something back and help young scholars do work that's extremely important—not just for me and my family, but for the civilized world," Craigie says. "I'd certainly encourage other alumni who have the resources, large or small, to find some part of the university that excites them and see what they can do to help."

Craigie continues to stay involved with Georgia State by serving on the College of Arts and Sciences' Board of Visitors and its Burning Bright campaign committee—and she says she is looking for additional ways to support an institution that has had such a lasting impact on her life.

Under this guiding principle, Ken, who enjoyed a successful career at Georgia-Pacific, Koch Industries and other companies, eagerly supported Connie as new and better professional opportunities came her way.

These opportunities included accounting roles at Ernst & Young, followed by a steady climb up the corporate ladder at The Coca-Cola Company, including division finance manager roles in Thailand and Germany and vice president-level finance and accounting roles at the company's headquarters in Atlanta.

Connie attributes much of her success to her diligent work ethic; a field (professional services) and company (Coca-Cola) that were supportive of women; and the excellent education and soft skills she gained at Georgia State—which Ken also credits for much of his success.

Both Connie and Ken have a long history of giving of their time, talent, connections and resources stretching all the way back to graduation from the J. Mack Robinson College of Business when they began supporting their alma mater with generous annual gifts. Connie has served on the Robinson College Advisory Board and as an Honors Program Mentor; Ken was involved as a professor of accountancy as well as a faculty advisor for Beta Alpha Psi.

Now retired, the McDaniels are deeply committed to continuing their support of education. Having already established a scholarship in the Robinson College, the couple wanted to do even more for the university.

Connie had been involved in giving her time and connections to support the launch of the Women Lead program, and she and Ken wanted to make a significant impact on this new initiative and on the Robinson College.

An undergraduate leadership program offered by the business school, the Women Lead initiative encourages female students to aspire to leadership positions in their careers. The program's signature component is the Women Lead in Business course, which offers lectures, guest speakers, corporate visits and mentoring opportunities for students.

Over several meetings with Nancy
Mansfield, a faculty member in the
Robinson College and the Honors
College, Ken decided to surprise Connie
and endow a Women Lead professorship
in their names. Indeed, Connie was
surprised and thrilled when Richard
Phillips, dean of the Robinson College,
announced at an October 2015 Women
Lead reception that Ken had established
the Connie and Ken McDaniel Professorship fund. The fund creates and endows
a faculty role for the Women Lead in
Business course.

"I was excited. The Women Lead program really clicked with me," Connie says. "I know how important it is, particularly for undergraduate women, to get the leadership lessons in that stage of their development, as opposed to later, when most of us entered the workforce."

Ken concurs, "Georgia State is on the forefront of innovation in education, and I think the Women Lead program is a wonderful example of that. Connie was very fortunate to work for a company that supported women's initiatives, but you read that glass ceilings are still out there. I hope the program helps shatter those ceilings and gives women the opportunities everyone deserves."

Nancy Mansfield is incredibly grateful for the McDaniel's support of the Women Lead program. "The Connie and Ken McDaniel Women Lead Professorship is an enduring way of ensuring that the university will publicly endorse and honor outstanding faculty in perpetuity," says Mansfield. "It honors the work of faculty who contribute to the mission of Women Lead—to empower undergraduate women to aspire to and achieve leadership roles."

Furthermore Mansfield says, "The professorship elevates the importance of what we do, it provides a platform for important research, and it sustains the Women Lead program, providing transformative educational experiences for our students and opening doors for women. Connie and Ken's hearts and minds are committed to unlocking the full potential of our students and placing them on a trajectory for success. The endowed professorship will make sure their legacy continues—and we are most grateful."




FOUNDATION ENDOWNMENT POOL BALANCE
